The European School was founded in 1989 as a humanities focused K-12 institution in Heredia, Costa Rica with an English-based curriculum. The innovative literature-based educational program recognizes each student as an entire being with different gifts and limitations, needs and abilities, and hope for the future. The European School is presently serving 530 students from over forty countries around the world. The European School is accredited by Costa Rica's Ministry of Public Education as well as the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO).

Bilingual Education

Bilingualism is part of the school philosophy. All European School classes are taught in English from kindergarten on apart from one daily period of Spanish language and literature. French is introduced as a third language as of seventh grade and may give the student enough proficiency to further their studies in a French-speaking university.

Final grades for the 11th and 12th grade students break down into 50% final semester exams and 50% quarter grades. The passing grade at our school is 70%.

We do not report Class Rank or GPA.

Students are enrolled in the IB May Exam Session each year. IB scores are available on July 6 each year and students apply to university with their IB Predicted Scores.

The Academic Program

Once a student finishes 10th grade, he or she must enroll in the IB Diploma Program, as it is the only pathway we offer to graduate from the European School.

Our students must take both English A HL (Literature or Language and Literature) and Spanish A HL (Literature or Language and Literature), and then choose four other courses from the list of courses offered at our school which are:

- Geography *or* History (SL or HL)
- Math Analysis and Approaches *or* Math Applications and Interpretations (SL or HL)
- Chemistry or Biology (SL or HL) or Environmental Studies and Systems (SL)
- French B or Visual Arts (SL or HL) or a second science subject

Additionally, students undertake two year courses in Theory of Knowledge, Creativity, Activity, and Service, and complete a 4,000 word Extended Essay on a research topic of their choice as required to earn their IB Diploma.
